If there is a topic you would like to discuss in the WSAE community, consider writing a blog. It's easier than you think.

1. Log into the WSAE Connected Community.
2. Scroll down to the end of the blogs window.
3. Click on the word "post" on the lower right.
4. Give your blog an interesting title. Think headline, not label.
5. Write the body of your message in the window. If you prefer, you can write your blog in Word first. When you copy and paste your text into the box, be sure to use the "Paste from Word" tool on the toolbar. It looks like the MS Word logo with a paintbrush on it.
6. Use the format tools on the toolbar if you want to change the appearance.
7. Modify the audience or stick with the default choices (recommended).
8. Click "publish" at the bottom of the screen.

Congratulations – you're a blogger! (Be sure to mention it at dinner – your teenage children will be impressed.)
